

Control Panel Quick Guide

Check that the water level is well above the water level detectors. These are the two metal studs in the tub shell near to the filter housing. If the water level is low, top it up to well above the detectors.

Turn the main power to your tub off. Leave it for 60 seconds. Turn the main power to the tub back on.

Your screen should display. Three small dashes, temperature, time.

Set the current time using “hour” and “minute” buttons.

Press the button with the word “cycle” underneath it.

Use the button with the word “hour” underneath it to set a filtration period “start time”

Press the button with “Set” underneath it. The time will change, so use the “hour” button to set the filtration “Duration” recommended duration is 4 hours

Press the red “power” button.

Screen should now show.

Temperature, time, three dashes, small circle made of two arrows, the word “Off”

If the word “On” appears below the small circle, press the button with the word “preheat” underneath it twice, this should change the word displayed to “Off”

Press the power button, three dashes will disappear from the screen.

Set the required temperature by pressing the button with a thermometer symbol and the Degrees C letter. Keep pressing it until you reach the desired temperature.

Press the button with the word “preheat” underneath it.

The circulation pump will start, also the heater symbol will appear on your screen, this looks like a small thermometer with wavy lines across it. The heater symbol will flash for a few seconds while the control system checks for correct water flow.

If there is correct water flow, the heater symbol will then come on fixed, this means the heater is now working to heat the water.

Your tub is now heating in a temperature controlled way to maintain the water temperature.

The heater symbol should be on the screen at all times either flashing or fixed.

If the fountains are running, turn them off. There will be a control valve for this on the top of the tub. The valve for the fountains will have a rounded triangle shape handle which when turned clockwise will close the valve for the fountains.

Fountains are operated by the circulation pump so will only work when this is running.

To turn on the fountains manually, press the button on the control panel that is a circle made of two arrows. This is the manual on off switch for the circulation pumps, so remember to turn it off or the pump will continue to run 24 hours a day.
